A. General Update

- Michelle Bogle submitted written administrative update
- Received and reviewing two paving quotes
- Discussed getting a survey of the main complex property and possibly writing a grant for it
- Blooming Green will plow the main complex this winter at no cost in exchange for a free ad banner
- Storage container going in tomorrow
- Keystone Tree fertilizing tomorrow
- Holiday party planned for 12/9/2025 at the German Club catered by Local's; Discussed and finalized guest list
- Discussed possibility of a DRVSA scholarship for a Pennridge High School senior awarded annually
- Reviewed Carson Helicopters lease renewal including notice required to terminate the agreement; Club to renew lease for a one-year term
- BJ Gibbons to attend January meeting to discuss sponsorships; Nick Gontkosky and Evan Lowery taking banners down

B. Snack Stand

- Michelle Bogle met with Bacco; Will continue partnership in 2026
- Considered how Bacco could use club's tax exempt status for snack stand purchases
- Bacco negotiating club's percentage of sales from 25% to 17% and Bacco paying \$500 per month for utilities instead of \$400; Discussion needed

- Will adjust days snack stand is open
- Net snack stand revenue was \$2,500 for the fall and \$4,348 for the spring

C. Used Equipment Sale Recap

- High school students who organized the used equipment sale presented \$516 in proceeds to the club to be used in a scholarship fund
- May need additional storage options and have a longer donation period for next fundraiser

D. Presentation by Christopher Chookagian, PHS Field Hockey Coach

- Christopher explained his playing and coaching background in field hockey
- Field hockey is growing in the U.S.
- Presented the possibility of starting a field hockey program at DRVSA as a feeder program for the high school
- Closest existing program is in Souderton
- Program would start as intramural for ages K-8
- Discussed field space; Possibly use Pennridge school fields and/or Quakertown fields
- Considered season timing, best days for games (possibly Sundays) and/or a summer session
- May start by hosting clinics; 140 players attended clinic previously held
- Chris to follow-up with the board with a plan
